
- You will learn how to pronounce the Japanese syllabic nasal λ sound correctly.
- · You will practice pronouncing words with this sound.

The Japanese syllabic nasal sound is the δ sound in $\Box \& \delta$ and $\Box \& \delta \& \delta$. When the word has the syllabic nasal sound, you give it one mora.
