In this module:

- You will listen to words with LH pitch with particles.
- You will practice pronouncing words with LH pitch with particles.

When the pitch drops in the middle of a word (LHL pattern) or the pitch drops at the beginning of a word (HL pattern), it never goes back up when a particle comes after the word.

Examples 1: (1) 4-5-1

- 1. <u>コ</u>ーヒ<u>ーが</u> (あります) [(There is) coffee.]
- 2. レ<u>ストランが</u> (あります) [(There is) a restaurant.]

On the other hand, when the last pitch of a word is high, it may or may not drop at the particle as the following examples show (it depends on the type of the word/noun). When the words are homonyms (words with the same spelling or pronunciation but different meaning), the pitch is used to differentiate the meaning of the words.

Examples 2: (1) 4-5-2

1. <u>はなが</u> (きれいです) 2. <u>は</u>なが (おおきいです) [(The) flowers are (beautiful).] 2. <u>は</u>なが (おおきいです)
